**KO'OLAUPOKO HAWAIIAN CIVIC CLUB (KPHCC) SCHOLARSHIP
and FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

In order to process your application, you will need to submit the following items:

Your completed and signed **KPHCC Scholarship Application**.

Official Transcript (issued within six months of this application) must be sent to KPHCC no later than April 15. Transcripts must be mailed directly from the educational institution to KPHCC.

A **Letter of Acceptance** from the institution you will be attending for a post-high school program (first year only).

Two **(2) Letters of Recommendation** from teachers, counselors, ministers, and/or employers. Letters from friends and relatives will not be accepted. All letters must be mailed directly to KPHCC by the writer (address below).

Completed **Service Report Form** stating the types of service you are currently doing for others. Service may include any combination of the following: Unpaid community service through a non-profit organization, service to your school, community, assistance on a regular basis to aid a friend, family member or other individual/family that makes a significant impact on their well-being.

A*Personal Statement addressing the following items:

- Your reasons for attending college/university/trade school
- Your reasons for choosing your course of study
- Your career goals
- Any financial hardship, obstacles or special circumstances to be considered by the committee
- Your commitment to the preservation, cultivation and perpetuation of the native Hawaiian culture.....how do you hope to continue to perpetuate the culture in your career?
- Your involvement in community service and/or service to others

Your personal statement should also include other information that will demonstrate that you are a worthy scholarship recipient. Describe any outstanding attributes, talents and skills.

**Personal statements should be typed, double-spaced and a maximum 4 pages.
Please print "Personal Statement" at the top along with your first and last name.*

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The Bylaws of the Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club state, *"The Education and Scholarship Committee shall be responsible for monitoring the needs of native Hawaiian children in the area of our kuleana (Kane'ohe to Kualoa),"* therefore, preference is given to native Hawaiians.

Categories -

We will be accepting applications under the following categories:

- 1) Full-time student at accredited trade or occupational school OR 2 or 4 year college or university.
- 2) Part-time student at accredited trade or occupational school OR 2 or 4 year college or university (6 credit hours minimum).

Eligibility -

Applicant must:

- 1) Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 in a secondary school, or a traditional or non-traditional accredited two or four-year educational institution.
- 2) Have a GPA of at least 3.0 for graduate students enrolled in an accredited traditional or nontraditional institution of higher education.

Level -

Any post-high school education.

Geographic Area of Consideration -

Aid is only given to applicants who reside in the 96744 zip code area.

Volunteer Service Requirement -

An important component for scholarship award consideration is volunteer service. All applicants will be evaluated on documented, unpaid service they provide in any combination of the following: Community service through a non-profit organization, service to your school or church community, assistance on a regular basis to aid a friend, family member or other individual/family that makes a significant impact on their well-being. Current service should be completed in the 12 months prior to your scholarship application. Please submit the **Application Service Report Form** with your scholarship application.

**Volunteer service hours may be performed in conjunction with other scholarship/financial aid requirements from other organizations (KSBE, Alu Like, etc.).*

A vital part of the mission of the Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club is to malama our community. In that spirit, we expect that scholarship recipients will continue to perform volunteer service throughout the year. Specifically, they will be encouraged to donate at least twelve hours of their time to activities of the Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club in the year following their scholarship award.
